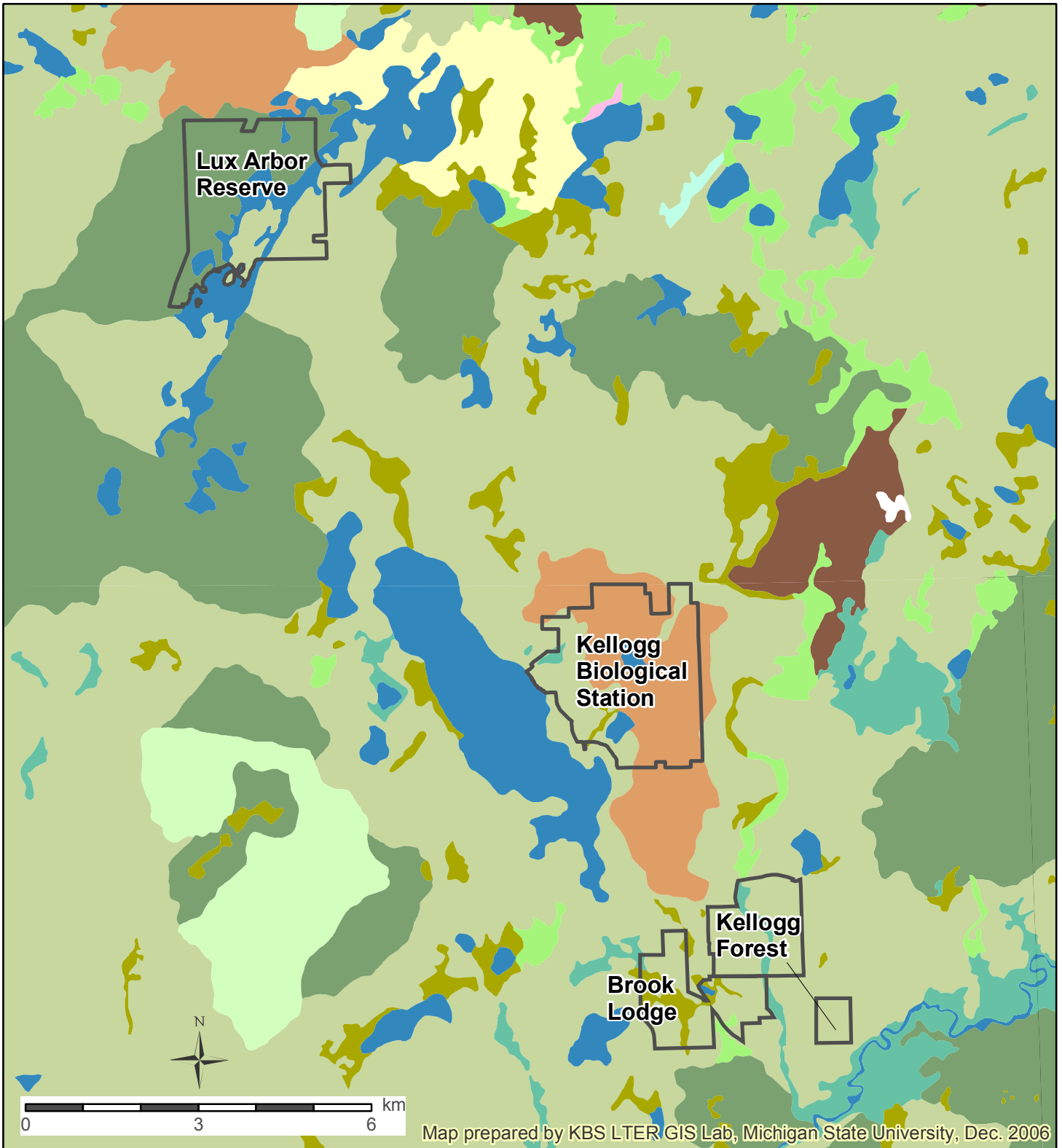















Kellogg Biological Station and Adjacent MSU Property Land Cover Circa 1830
